WITNESS SOUGHT

On Wed. 7th July, between 7-10.30 a.m., the local cat known as "Maggie May" was cruelly killed on the footpath outside the May Mission in Harman St. near the Grove Rd. corner.

A plastic shopping bag was tied tightly over her face to suffocate her and a vet said it would have taken 3-5 minutes to die this way. She was disposed of into a recycle bin close by, and when examined was found to have put up a fight to survive, as one paw was in the bag handle, another under her collar and the rear claws were fully extended.

Maggie May was a 13 year old black torti, who was deaf and blind, known for her "therapy visits" to Christchurch hospital and many city rest homes for the elderly over the last ten years. She traveled by car, often hanging her head out the drivers window as dogs do.


